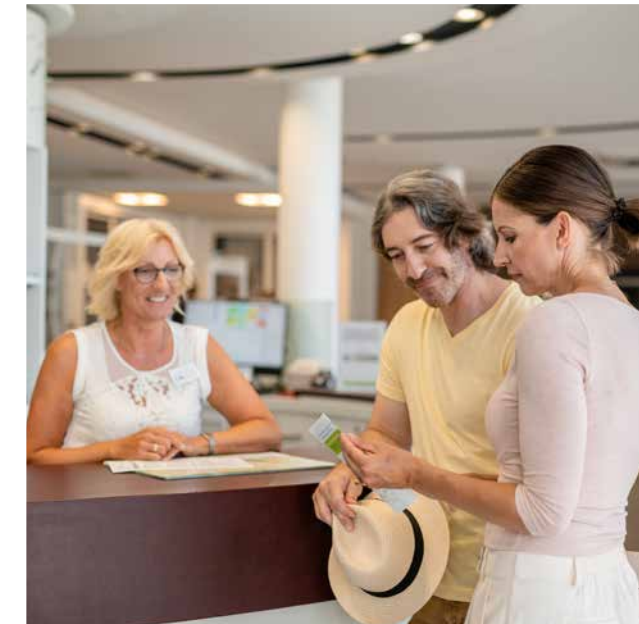

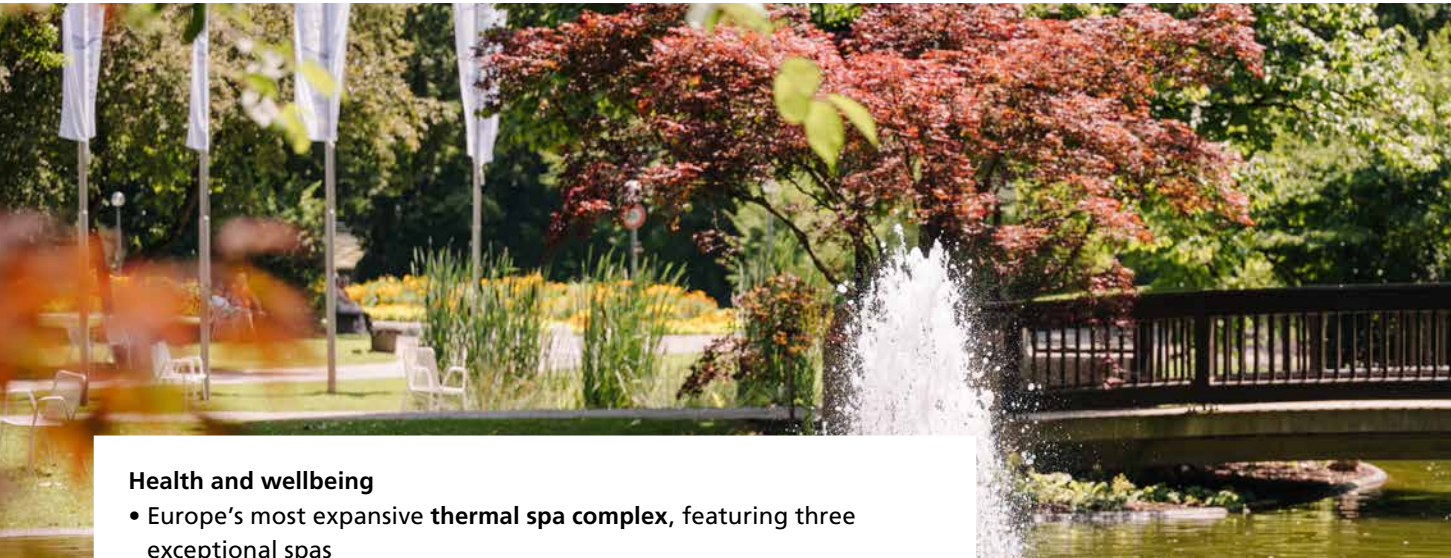

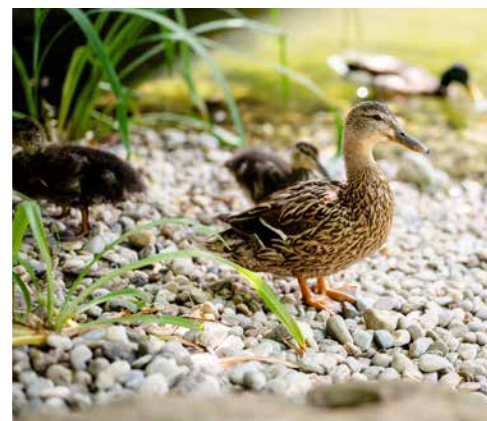

A JOURNEY THROUGH TIME – THEN AND NOW

The 1930s

THE STORY OF ONE OF EUROPE'S LEADING SPA RESORTS BEGAN BY PURE CHANCE IN 1938:

While drilling for oil, workers unexpectedly struck hot thermal water. At first, the spring remained unused, its discovery overshadowed by the outbreak of war.

The 1940s

HEALING WATERS: it wasn't until after 1945,

when residents of the Waldstadt refugee camp began using the spring, that its therapeutic effects became apparent. More and more people reported relief from joint and skin conditions – and before long, the first public bathing facility was established.

The 1960s

THE DAWN OF A NEW ERA:

In 1963, the Free State of Bavaria drilled Spring II. In 1964, this was followed by another borehole drilled by the husband-and-wife medical team, Dr. and Dr. Zwick – paving the way for Füssing's rise as a spa destination. In 1969, the district was officially granted the title "Bad" – a designation awarded to recognised spa towns in Germany, and one that marked the beginning of a new chapter in its history. The spa gardens were laid out in 1964/65.

The 1950s

IN 1950, THE SPRING WAS OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED AS A THERAPEUTIC SOURCE – A MILESTONE IN THE RESORT'S DEVELOPMENT.

Just three years later, a report by the Balneological Institute of the University of Munich confirmed the exceptional effectiveness of the thermal water in treating paralysis, skin conditions, osteoarthritis and rheumatic complaints. The positive experiences of early patients quickly brought Bad Füssing wider acclaim, extending well beyond Bavaria.

In 1957, development of the spa quarter began – culminating in the opening of the Kommunales Kurmittelhaus (Municipal Therapy Centre) in 1961.

The 2000s

BAD FÜSSING CONTINUED TO SET NEW STANDARDS IN THE 2000s:

The 18-hole golf course in Kirchham and the Saunahof sauna complex, with direct access to Therme Eins, further enriched the town's leisure and wellness offering. Multiple awards – for environmental stewardship, accessibility, allergy-friendly services and as Germany's top spa resort – have firmly secured Bad Füssing's place among Europe's leading health destinations.

Today, Bad Füssing is Europe's leading spa town for overnight tourism – with around two million stays per year, more than 12,000 guest beds, and a medical and therapeutic infrastructure that is second to none. E-mobility, digital guest services, new wellbeing experiences and sustainable concepts all show that the future of this spa town is every bit as vibrant as its past.

The 1970s

IN 1973, BAD FÜSSING RECORDED OVER ONE MILLION OVERNIGHT STAYS FOR THE FIRST TIME.

A period of rapid growth followed: the Kleines Kurhaus (small spa centre) was built, new clinics and thermal baths opened – and the once modest spa town began to flourish as a leading health resort.

The 1980s

THE 1980S BROUGHT NEW MOMENTUM:

With the opening of the Großes Kurhaus (main spa centre), the therapeutic exercise hall, and the expansion of clinics underground parking and leisure facilities, Bad Füssing evolved into a year-round destination for health and wellness. In 1985, the number of overnight stays reached a new record of 2.6 million – and the upward trend continued.

BAD FÜSSING – A PLACE WHERE HEALTH HAS DEEP ROOTS AND A BRIGHT FUTURE

1938

During oil drilling operations in Füssing – then a small hamlet with just six farms and 38 residents – a hot spring was discovered instead of oil.



1947

Staff from a UN refugee organisation discovered that the thermal water had healing properties. David Pearl, the director of the facility, built the first permanent bathhouse – the Pearl Bath – though access remained limited.

1949

Public bathing facilities opened for the first time.



1950

Official recognition as a healing spring, granted by the Bavarian State Ministry of the Interior.

1952

Thermal water analysis conducted by the Balneological Institute at the University of Munich.

1963/64

Thermal Springs II and III were drilled.

1969

The official title "Bad" was conferred, recognising Füssing as a certified spa town.

1971/72

The municipalities of Safferstetten, Würding, Eggfing and Aigen am Inn merged to form the new municipality of Bad Füssing.

1973

More than one million overnight stays were recorded for the first time.

1976

Construction of the leisure park.

1980

Opening of the Großes Kurhaus.



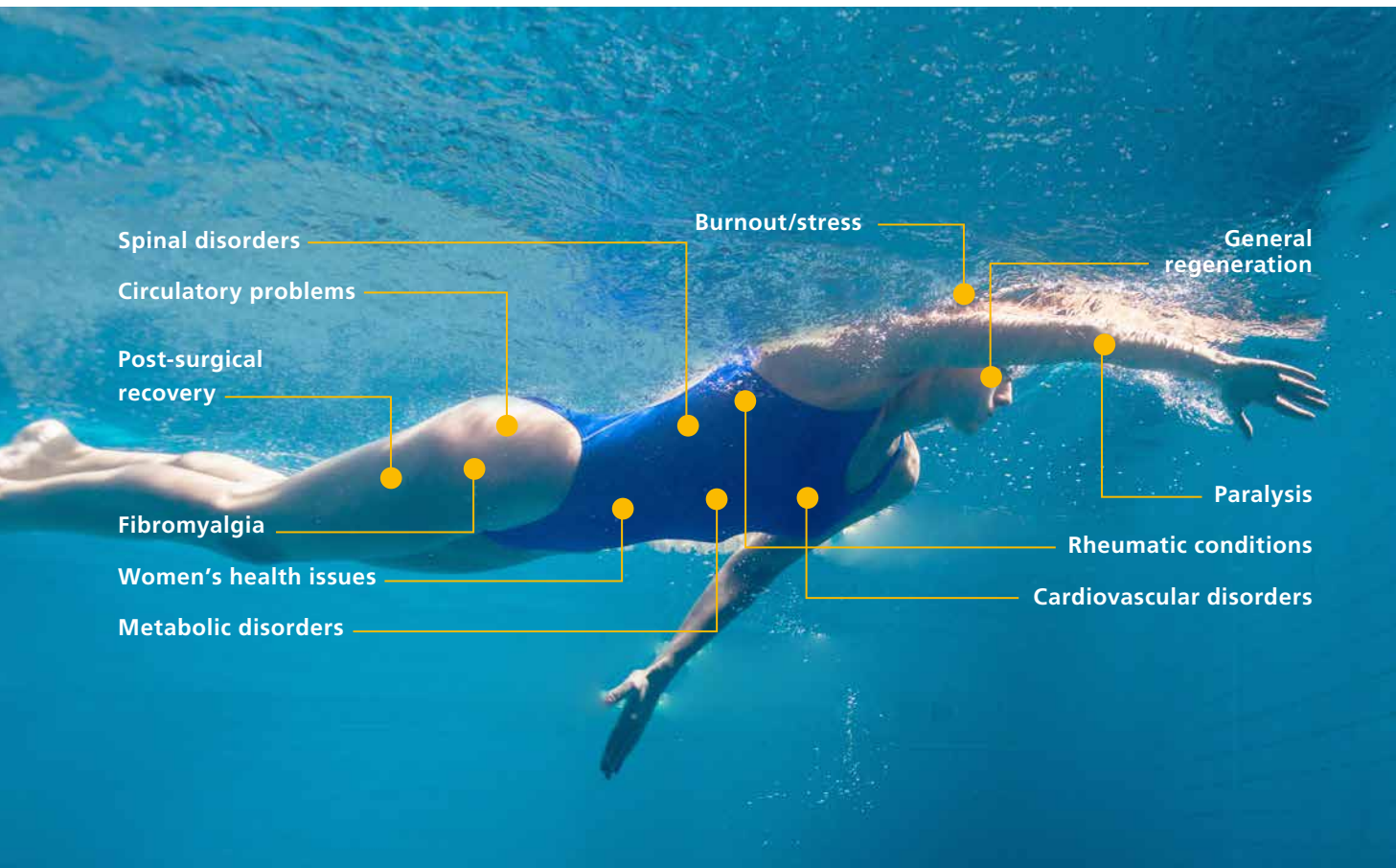
1988

By now, Bad Füssing had around 6,500 residents, 13,300 guest beds and recorded 3.2 million overnight stays in a single year.

Bad Füssing's springs are officially recognised healing waters – sulphur- and fluoride-rich sodium bicarbonate-chloride thermal springs, emerging from a depth of 1,000 m at a temperature of 56°C.

For therapeutic use, the recommended duration of a session in the thermal exercise pool is no more than 20 minutes.

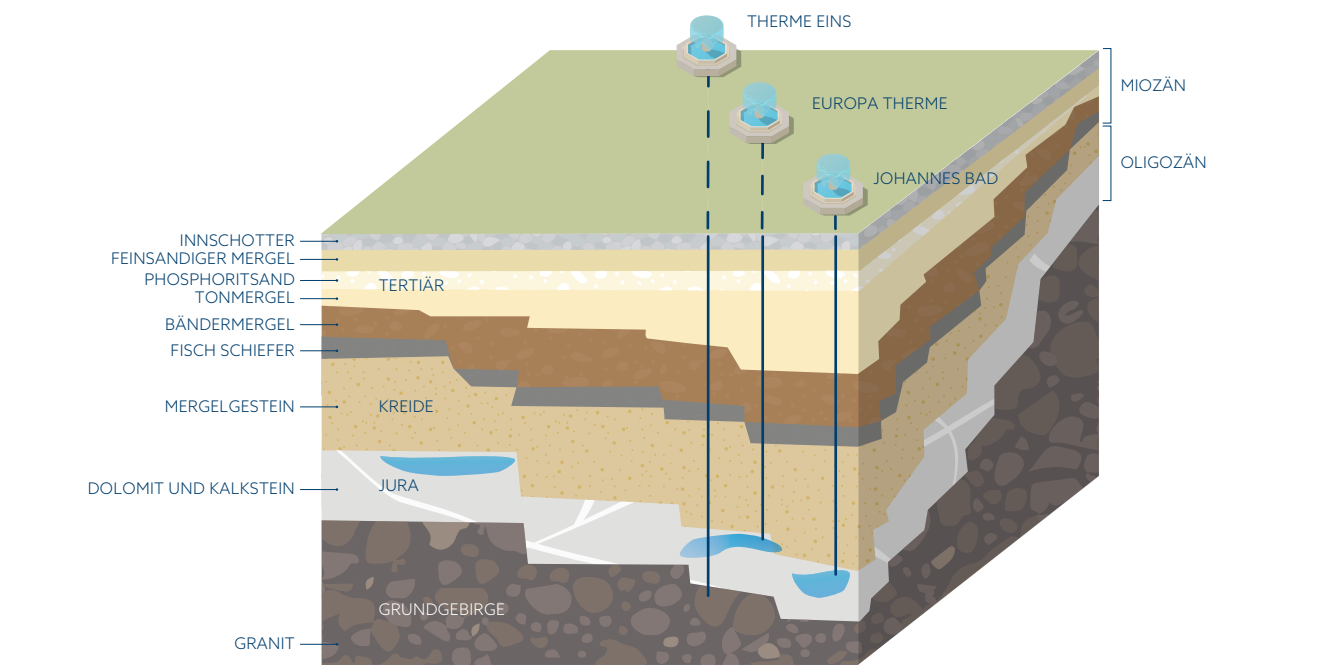

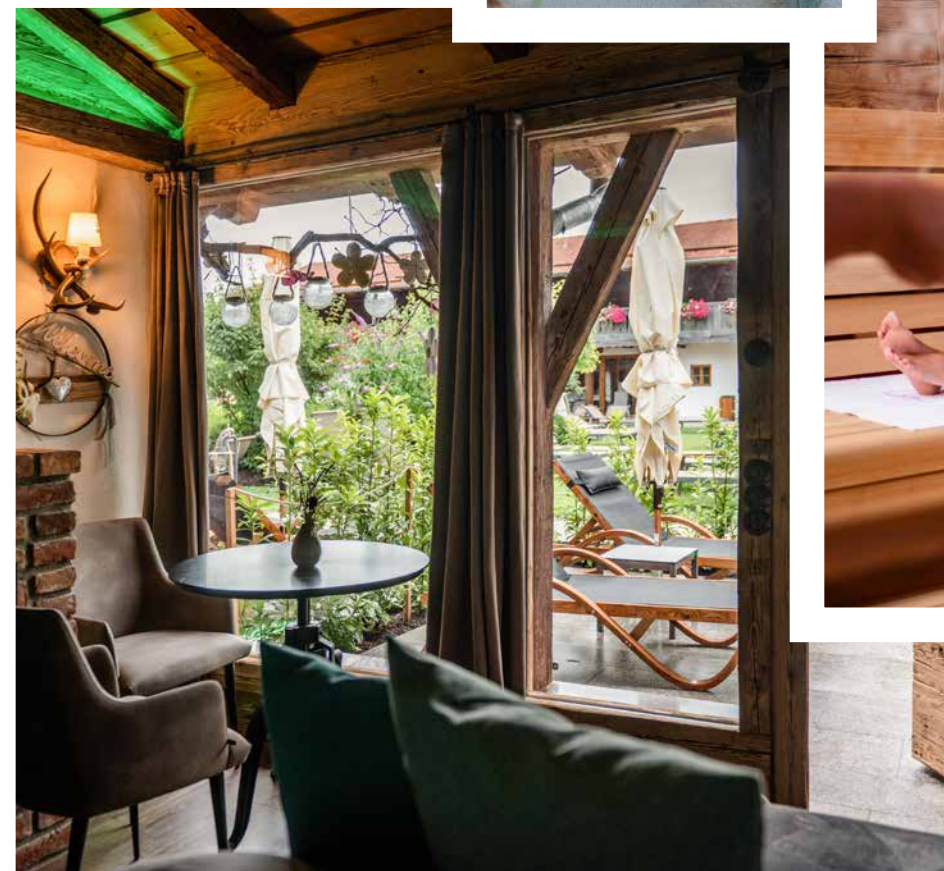


GEOLOGICAL BLOCK DIAGRAM OF THE THERMAL WATER SPRINGS IN BAD FÜSSING
